Support for the management of humane dog ownership

Contact of the government department about rabies control

On May 5th a villager in Jiajiang County of Leshan City, Sichuan was diagnosed with rabies. Sadly a storm of killing dogs then swept through Taiping and Baimiao Village in Jiajiang. Over 700 dogs were killed and buried after the bodies were sterilized. We received the news and immediately contacted the Sichuan Provincial Disease Prevention and Control Center who stated that it was the right "treatment" according to related local legal documents. Later we also contacted the Jiajiang Disease Prevention and Control Center, giving them our suggestions and sent them our materials about how to deal with wounds after dog bites. The local staff advised they would send the materials to the villagers.

Here, we mourn the loss of the 700 innocent dogs and remind everyone that rabies can be prevented and controlled. We hope the local government can spread information on the benefits of vaccines for dogs and related information to avoid such tragedies happening again.

Dog shelter guide book offered to the Shijiazhuang PSB

Shijiangzhuang PSB in Hebei province requested from Animals Asia leaflets and posters about caring for animals and dog ownership management. Those materials were for the local dog shelter and related public education activities in the community. We sent them the "Dog shelter guide book" and offered suggestions to the Shijiazhuang Dog Shelter, hoping that it would be a humane temporary home for stray dogs.



Continued launch of community education activities with Chengdu PSB

After a successful trial launch of public education in the communities of Chengdu with the Chengdu PSB, and receiving many positive feedbacks last year, we continued our project in the city's Jinjiang District in May. It was the 17th educational activity with Chengdu PSB in 2012. Through these activities, we hope to improve responsible dog ownership and solve any social problems involved in dog keeping in the community.

<u>Letter to Yulin government about Lychee Dog Meat Festival</u>

Recently we received many phone calls and emails protesting the Guangxi Province Yulin City's Lychee Dog Meat Festival which was set for June 21st. The festival boasted the good taste of eating lychee and dog meat together. We sent a letter to the local government demonstrating the cruelty of killing our companion animals as well as the illegal source of the dog meat, which is a health concern for the public. We urged the Yulin government to fully consider our suggestions and cancel the festival.

Protest to Shanxi Province Yulin City dog meat festival

Every May in northwest China's Shanxi Province Yulin City, a festival featuring local cuisine and dog meat is held. We joined hands with Xi'an Red Pomegranate Companion Animal Rescue Center and many animal welfare groups from around the country and sent a joint letter to the government protesting the festival.

Support to animal welfare groups

11 animal welfare groups from 5 cities of Beijing, Anshan, Nanjing, Chengdu and Shijiazhuang requested public education materials of over 4,000 leaflets and 94 posters from Animals Asia. Groups in Chengdu and Anshan distributed the leaflets during their local events.

Sichuan Ya'an Citiy Animal Adoption Center and volunteers from Sichuan College of Forestry launched a public





education event on May 19th in the local communities to encourage responsible dog ownership. The activity received great attention and support from local citizens. Animals Asia supported the event and offered many suggestions to the construction of the adoption center and future events.
