Cocoon's story

Cocoon was just a tiny cub when she was rescued from the back of a wildlife trafficker's motorbike by the Vietnam's border police. Not only was she snatched from the wild, she almost certainly saw her mother killed as she would have fought fiercely to protect her cub. Who knows what fate would have awaited her at the hands of these traffickers. Young cubs just like Cocoon are often sold into circuses, or destined for a lifetime of pain on bile farms. Thankfully kind supporters like you were there for her in her time of need, and we were able to bring her home to our sanctuary.

As a new rescue, Cocoon was terrified, wary of her new surroundings, of her new bear carers. But in a matter of days, this beautiful young cub let her curiosity get the better of her. She delighted in new tastes, sounds and textures. She found her appetite, felt safe enough to rest and found a love for toys. After settling in and having her first health check, Cocoon was moved to our special Cub House where she quickly made her first friends. Today, this mischievous, fun-loving little bear spends her days playing with besties Mudky and Yen.

Cocoon feels the love of our entire Animals Asia family every day. Moon bears like Cocoon can live up to 30 years. She'll need a lifetime of food, expert healthcare and love. A gift in your Will could make all the difference for beautiful bears like Cocoon in their time of need. Your gift could help give them a life filled with joy and love instead of pain and suffering.

H'Plo's story

Imagine spending your life trapped in chains and forced to carry tourists in Vietnam's suffocating heat. That was the reality for poor H'Plo until she felt the love of supporters like you and we could bring her to sanctuary.

Gentle H'Plo was 46 when she came into our care in 2020. She'd spent her entire life working in Dak Lak, a tourist hotspot for elephant-riding.

H'Plo's back was hunched under the strain of the heavy seat, her feet cracked and aching. But now, she roams freely through the lush forests of Yok Don National Park, surrounded by the beauty of the natural world.

Not only did our kind supporters allow us to rescue H'Plo, in 2021 we signed a legally binding agreement with Dak Lak Province to end elephant-riding there.

With the help of supporters like you, we're ending elephant riding forever in Vietnam. By leaving a gift in your Will to Animals Asia, you can ensure elephants like H'Plo experience the joy of freedom and a life free from suffering. with your Will

It's very easy to include Animals Asia in your Will. Here are some simple steps you can follow to make sure you can look after your loved ones and most treasured organisations when you're gone.

- Find a solicitor who will ensure your wishes will be carried out exactly as you wish.

 Once you've found your solicitor, it's normally a quick and easy process to write your Will
- Think about your assets and the loved ones and/or organisations you'd like to remember in your Will. If you'd like to leave a gift to Animals Asia, you'll need our charity details which are Animals Asia Foundation (Australia) Limited ABN 53 107 630 357, Level 1, 8 Beulah Road, Norwood, SA 5067, Australia; New Zealand Post Box: PO Box 6679, Victoria Street West, Auckland 1142, New Zealand
- Your gift can be a specific sum, a percentage of your estate, the remainder of your estate after your other commitments, or a specific item like a property or shares
- Once your Will has been written, it's important to update it from time to time to make sure it still reflects your wishes. If you'd like to update your existing Will, it's simple to amend using a codicil, a separate document that amends or adds to your existing Will. So for example, you could add Animals Asia as a beneficiary to your Will with this document, while leaving the rest of your instructions untouched
- Appoint one or more people to be your Executor (the person responsible for seeing your wishes are carried out). This can be a friend, relative or your solicitor
- Make a copy of your Will and make sure someone you trust knows the location of your original. Your solicitor will be able to help with advice on storing your Will safely

Types of gift

Residuary gifts – This kind of gift means you can look after your loved ones first, before choosing a percentage of your estate to leave to charity. A residuary gift is a share of the value of your assets, such as your property or saving. Most supporters choose to leave Animals Asia this kind of gift as it's a percentage of your estate, rather than a fixed amount – meaning it won't lose its value over time.

Pecuniary gifts – A pecuniary gift is a specific amount of money of your choosing, also known as a cash gift. This gift will be a fixed sum, regardless of any changes in the value of your estate.

Specific gifts – Some of our supporters choose to leave specific items that are special to them, like a property, jewellery or artwork.

Wording for your Will – We recommend you get legal advice regarding the wording of your Will. If you're planning on leaving a residuary gift, a suggestion of the wording you could use is:

"I give free of all duties and taxes the residue/a % of the residue of my estate to Animals Asia Foundation (Australia) Limited (ABN 53 107 630 357) of Level 1, 8 Beulah Road, Norwood, SA 5067, Australia, for its general purposes"

Inheritance Tax – Gifts in Wills are not subject to inheritance or estate tax. But there may be other taxes, like capital gains tax, depending on the circumstances of the gift. We recommend seeking professional legal advice for any tax implications with your estate.



Some common questions about leaving a gift in your Will

Do Animals Asia really need a gift from me?

Yes. Animals Asia relies on the generosity and kindness of supporters like you to continue caring for and rescuing animals. Every gift, no matter the size, makes a difference. The animals whose lives you've touched through your compassion thank you from the bottom of their hearts for considering a gift in your Will.

Will my gift make a difference?

Absolutely. Leaving a gift in your Will means you can continue to make a positive impact on the world long after you're gone. Your gift will support hundreds of rescued animals, providing them with lifelong care. And your voice will be heard into the future calling for animal welfare and conservation.

Do I need a solicitor?

We recommend you consult a solicitor when writing or amending your Will to ensure that your wishes are clearly stated and legally binding. A solicitor can also provide advice on tax implications and other legal matters related to your gift.

I've just written my Will. Do I have to rewrite it completely if I want to leave Animals Asia a gift?

No. You can simply add a codicil, which is a separate document that amends or supplements your existing Will. Your solicitor can help you prepare a codicil to include a gift to Animals Asia.
